OECD survey says that agrofuels will only have limited impact on climate change.

The OECD report estimates that the US alone spends USD 7 billion a year to help producing ethanol, with each tonne of CO₂ avoided costing more than USD 500. The survey asks governments to scrap subsidies for agrofuels because the current rush leads to increasing food prices and is a threat to natural habitats.
