## Green MEPs take to the streets to protest austerity measures

The exclusive focus on cuts in the name of fiscal prudence will not only exacerbate growing social inequalities, hitting the most vulnerable the hardest, it will also jeopardise our social and economic recovery by stymieing investments in Europe's future."

Belgian Green MEP Philippe Lamberts (Ecolo) added:

"While sound public finances are an essential condition for a sustainable economy, the exclusive focus of most EU governments on fiscal austerity is both socially unfair and economically wrong. The preoccupation with cuts risks condemning Europe to a downward economic spiral, undermining the prospects of a domestic-driven recovery."
