Greens/EFA group welcomes Portuguese MEP Rui Tavares as new member

Portuguese MEP **Rui Tavares** has announced his intention to join the Greens/EFA group in the European Parliament. Mr Tavares, who was elected in 2009 as an independent on the 'Bloco de Esquerda' list in Portugal, previously sat with the GUE/NGL group. Mr Tavares first contacted the group this Monday, 20 June.
