"Viktor Orbán is not representing the EU in Georgia today. Once again, Orbán is exploiting Hungary's Council Presidency to serve his own interests, favoring pro-Russian allies and spreading misinformation.

"These elections were far from democratic. As an official observer for the European Parliament, our mission witnessed repeated voting, voter intimidation, physical assaults, and even instances of individuals casting multiple ballots. All reported violations during election day must be investigated and addressed."
